In what ways does the Holy Spirit testify about Jesus?

What is the logic of John's argument found in vs. 9? What are we saying about God if we fail to believe the testimony of the water, blood, and Spirit?

What is at stake in receiving or rejecting God's testimony about Jesus?

Apply Together

What does it mean to HAVE eternal life right now?

As a part of receiving an eternal and abundant life now, what does God testify about us?
