Community Group Discussion Guide – Acts 3:1-26

Study Together

What do you think was the mindset of the beggar?

How did Peter treat the beggar?

The lame beggar asked for money, but Peter and John gave him so much more. Why do you think they gave him physical healing instead of charity?

Whose power and authority healed the lame beggar (v. 16)?

Why is salvation often connected to physical healing in the ministry of Jesus and His Apostles (Luke 5:12-26; 6:6-11; 8:42-48; 17:11-19; 18:35-43)?

What are the 3 components of our restoration? (Vs. 19-21)

What do you think Peter means when he tells the crowd in vs. 19 “repent, and turn back...?”

Apply Together

Repent:

What is one area in your life right now where you feel a need for relief?

In that area of your life, what would complete restoration from Jesus look like?

Do your prayers reflect a deep desire for relief or a desire for restoration?

Believe:

What did Jesus do in order to heal our relationship with God?

What is your greatest need today: to experience God’s forgiveness, to experience God’s refreshing presence, or to experience great hope in God’s future restoration?

Obey:

How might Jesus be calling you to be a means of healing/blessing this week, even in the midst of your own hardships?

Pray Together

Tell Jesus that you want to know Him more than you want relief from whatever suffering or hardship you are experiencing today
