Colossians Part 8 – Study & Discussion Guide

Preparation for Group Time:

- Read Colossians 2:6-15. Highlight key words and phrases.
- Listen to the sermon “Christ is Enough” by Pastor Andrew
- Answer the questions below

Questions

Bible Study Question: Colossians 2:6 says “as you received Christ Jesus as Lord, so walk in him...”

How did you receive Christ? What do you think it means to walk in Him?

Evaluation Question: Read Colossians 2:8

Think about your formative years, what were the “traditions of men” espoused in your home? If not overtly stated, how were these traditions and values applauded in your home?

Think about your home and persona life now – What are some “traditions of men” that threaten the centrality of Christ in your life and home?

Bible Study Question: Read Colossians 2:11-12

What does Paul mean when he says we have been circumcised? What has been cut off?

How were we circumcised?

Bible Study Question: In Colossians 2:9-15 the term “in Him” or “with Him” is used 7 times.

Find and list each use of these terms. What are the objects/realities that are found “in Him” or “with Him?”

Application Questions:

Of all the benefits that come “in Christ” or “with Christ” which benefit is most encouraging to your soul today given your present struggles? Why?

Apply your answer to the previous question to living out your life. (For example “because my old self has been cut off,” it means I am no longer enslaved to a particular temptation in my life and I am, by the power of the Spirit, able to resist.)
