Questions

Bible Study:

From Ephesians 5:22-33 – List out significant Biblical principles for marriage found in this passage:

What is the “role” of the husband in the Scriptures? What is the posture he is to take in fulfilling that role?

Evaluation & Repentance:

What are some false views of submission that either men or women might have?

What is the Biblical understanding of submission?

What are some false views and distortions of Biblical leadership?

What does Biblical leadership in a marriage look like?

As you processed through the false vs. Biblical approaches to submission and leadership how were you convicted of ways in which you fall short in your own character and life?
